

## **Memorandum of Understanding**

## Between Universitas Muhammadiyah Surakarta and Asia University



This Memorandum of Understanding is signed in recognition of existing good relations that have been developed between Universitas Muhammadiyah Surakarta and Asia University, Taiwan and in anticipation of the further strengthening of this partnership in the future.

The two parties commit themselves to expanding and enhancing the academic, educational and cultural cooperation and collaboration between their institutions through the following ways:

- 1. Promote the exchange of faculty members and students for lectures, seminars, discussions, semester program, summer program, internship, and cultural activities
- 2. Organise and participate in joint academic activities such as conference, workshops, publications, and seminars
- 3. Conduct joint collaboration in the development of programs and learning content
- 4. Promote joint research in areas of common interest
- 5. Cooperate and collaborate in other forms agreed upon by both Parties

This Memorandum is not intended to create binding or legal obligations on either party. As and when details of any of the above activities are developed, such details, especially those requiring financial resources, will be discussed and set forth in agreements to be separately executed by the methods of cooperation stipulated in this Memorandum.

This Memorandum shall become effective on the date of signing and may be modified, changed or terminated by mutual consent via written notice 6 months prior to the termination. Should the termination of this MOU happen, the then ongoing collaborative activities will continue until the terms and conditions of collaboration expire and should dispute arises due to the termination both parties agree to resolve any issue in question amicably to ensure minimum disruption to the ongoing activities.
